# December 1, 2023 Rich Valley Elementary School Grade One



The students are definitely getting into the holiday spirit and we have started the count down to Christmas morning by colouring pictures with 24 numbers on them. The students will colour one number per day until they reach the number one which means they will be very excited the next morning.

### Math

The students are continuing to work in a number booklet that will assist them in understanding quantity, more or less, most, between, and least as well as number order. They are counting sets and printing the appropriate number for that set or they are identifying a number and drawing objects to match that number. The students are also ordering numbers starting from different numbers 0 through 50.



# Language Arts

The students have been reviewing the tool sounds throughout the week. They have been identifying the letters that make up the tool sound and printing these letters on their white board. They have also drawn pictures and printed the word to match the picture, all of which have a tool sound in them. The students were also introduced to the -ail word family. Poor Snail had trouble getting his community mail on time. Ask your child how Snail solved his problem.

### Science

This week was all about humans moving up, down, left or right and animals or objects that roll. We discussed the two words direction and distance. Direction is the path a person, animal or object takes and distance is how far someone or something travels. The students had to follow directions and distance to move a character from one location to another. For animals and objects that roll, we discussed the fun a person can have with objects that roll such as a soccer ball and the importance of objects that roll such as a wheel. We also discussed how different animals roll into a ball to protect themselves.
