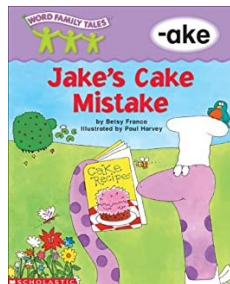


Language Arts
